### Workshop Description

Students will explore multiple areas of the music industry including audio engineering, live events, composition, and business. They will work in groups to utilize samples, loops, and virtual instruments to create a short music track within GarageBand, followed by a discussion about the best way to market their track to a target audience.

### Workshop Length

This workshop experience can be adjusted to accommodate **45 - 90 minute** class schedules.

### Learning Goals

At the close of this workshop, participants will be able to:

**Identify** multiple careers paths within the music industry.

**Create** a three to five track music composition using Audio files by completing the following five objectives:

1. Navigate a DAW (Digital Audio Workstation) environment
2. Identify basic song elements for different genres (tempo, key, rhythm, melodies)
3. Add loops
4. Add effects to stylize a song
5. Add vocal melody to see it all come together

### Set-up & Preparation

All supplies, including iPads and speakers, will be provided by our facilitator for this workshop and we can present throughout the day to accommodate multiple classes. Teachers are also welcome to select a different workshop experience for each class.
