

CORONAVIRUS DISEASE 2019 (COVID-19) TRAVEL GUIDANCE

Full Sail University continues to closely monitor the coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19). In response to recent State of Florida, Office of the Governor, Executive Order Number 20-51, the University is providing this travel guidance for faculty, staff, and students who are planning or returning from international travel.

TRAVELING ABROAD

In response to the COVID-19 outbreak, the Centers for Disease Control ([CDC](#)) is prohibiting or restricting non-essential travel to or from the following countries:

CDC Recommendation	Affected Countries
CDC recommends that travelers avoid all nonessential travel to the following destinations. Entry of foreign nationals from these destinations has been suspended.	China and Iran
CDC recommends that travelers avoid all nonessential travel to the following destinations:	Italy and South Korea
CDC recommends that older adults or those who have chronic medical conditions consider postponing travel to the following destinations:	Japan
Travelers should practice usual precautions at the following destination:	Hong Kong

RETURNING FROM INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL

As recommended by Governor Ron DeSantis and State Surgeon General Dr. Scott Rivkees, we request that all faculty, staff, and students returning from travel from the affected countries: China, Iran, Italy, Japan and South Korea, self-quarantine and not return to campus for fourteen days (14) after their return.
